Public meeting scheduled for Riverside Park

Meeting to focus on Master Plan Update

MUSCATINE, Iowa – The City of Muscatine will host the final public meeting to discuss the Riverside Park Master Plan Update from 5:30-7:30 p.m. on Wednesday, May 10, at the Riverview Center, 110 Harbor Drive, Muscatine, Iowa. A presentation discussing the recommendations will be given at 6:00 p.m. The remainder of the meeting will follow an open house format.

The purpose of this public meeting is to share details regarding the Riverside Park Master Plan Update that will ultimately develop a long-term vision for the park. The park elements have been refined from comments received at prior meetings with the public and local officials. The plan update will be on display, and attendees will be given the opportunity to again provide written or verbal comments. Representatives from the city and its consultant, Short Elliott Hendrickson Inc. (SEH), will be available to discuss the plan update and address any questions or concerns.

The Riverside Park Master Plan will be presented to the City Council for their adoption once the plan has been finalized. A timeline for the implementation of the Riverside Park Master Plan will be subject to availability of outside funding.
