In-Depth City Council Minutes
7:00 p.m. – September 10, 2020

This meeting was held electronically due to meeting regulations regarding the spread of COVID-19.

Mayor Broderson called the City Council In-Depth meeting for Thursday, September 10, 2020, to order at 7:00 p.m. Councilmembers present were: Froelich, Malcolm, Gordon, Brockert, Jindrich and Brackett. Councilmember Hopkins was not present.

Mayor Broderson started the meeting with a discussion regarding trick or treating for Halloween 2020. She stated that trick or treating would be on Oct 31, 2020 from 5:30-7:30. Mayor Broderson stated that trick or treating could be done using safety precautions such as proper handwashing, social distancing, wearing masks etc. She suggests that if anyone is uncomfortable with this because of safety they do not have to participate and to not turn on their porch light.

Councilmember Brackett moved to approve a purchase agreement with Stanley Center for Peace and Security for the purchase of the former Musser Public Library. Seconded by Councilmember Gordon. Vote: All ayes – 1 absent (Hopkins)

There was a presentation by Stanley Center for Peace and Security Members describing the plans for the renovation of the library to become their headquarters.

Nick Gow from Muscatine Parks and Recreation gave a presentation on the Eagle Scout Projects completed within the City of Muscatine that have benefited both the City and the Scout.
