**INTRODUCTION:** Stanley Consultants has completed the plans and specs for renovation of the Bond and Schley lift stations. Estimated cost is around \$200,000. A public hearing is required.

**RECOMMENDATION/RATIONALE:** Attached is a resolution setting a public hearing for June 7, 2012. This resolution needs to be on the agenda for the May 17, 2012 council meeting. There is currently \$300,000 budgeted for the renovation of these two lift stations and improvements to the Slough Pumping building. Staff is willing to handle the improvements at the Slough with our own people.
