RESOLUTION FOR FINAL ACCEPTANCE OF THE NEW
SOUTH END FIRE STATION PROJECT (A/K/A MUSCATINE
FIRE STATION NO. 2)

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of March, 2011, the City of Muscatine, Iowa, and First Construction Group of Burlington, Iowa entered into a construction contract for the construction of certain public improvements generally described as the New South End Fire Station Project (a/k/a Muscatine Fire Station No. 2); and

WHEREAS, the City has identified certain deficiencies in the performance of the construction contract but has determined that it should finally accept the Project and move forward to effectuate the resolution of all claims against the Retainage and Performance Bond including claims by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUSCATINE, IOWA:

Section 1. That the New South End Fire Station Project (a/k/a Muscatine Fire Station No. 2) is Finally Accepted by the City of Muscatine.

Section 2. That the City Administrator and City Attorney are authorized to proceed to resolve all legitimate claims against the Retainage and Performance Bond including the filing of legal action pursuant to Iowa Code Section 573. Resolution of the claims may be accomplished through mediation.
