Introduction: The City of Muscatine received and accepted a grant from the Iowa Economic Development Authority to complete a downtown revitalization project. The City of Muscatine entered into a contract with HBK Engineering for engineering services to design, prepare plans, specifications, bid documents, and construction oversight for the CDBG Downtown Revitalization Project.

BACKGROUND: The public hearing to consider the final plans and specifications is being delayed and rescheduled until October 15, 2015 to allow the CDBG Grant Administrator to review the plans and specifications before publicizing bid documents. A contract for CDBG Grant Administration is expected to be completed and presented for council's consideration on October 8, 2015.

RECOMMENDATION/RATIONALE: It is recommended that City Council approve the resolution setting the public hearing to consider the plans, specifications, form of contract, cost estimate, and establishing a bid opening date related to the Muscatine CDBG Downtown Revitalization Project, IEDA Project No. 13-DTR-001.

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the plans, specifications, cost estimate, and establishing a bid opening date is set for Thursday, October 15, 2015, at 7:00 p.m.;
