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### **INTRODUCTION:**

The police Department would like to declare three of our old/retired squad light bars to be declared surplus property. These three light bars were replaced with new light bars and installed on our newer squads.

### **BACKGROUND:**

These were purchased approx. 4-6 years ago and were taken off a couple of our older squad cars that are no longer in service.

### **RECOMMENDATION/RATIONALE:**

The police department has no further use for these three light bars, having replaced them with three newer more efficient light bars. If approved, it is the police department's intention to sell two (2) of the light bars to another government agency (Muscatine County Sheriff's Department.) They are interested in purchasing the light bars for some of their vehicles. Considering the age/model of the light bars, the police department believes that a fair price for the light bars is \$350. The remaining light bar will possibly be purchased by the Sheriff's Department in the near future. If not we will only sell/give the last light bar to another law enforcement agency.
