INTRODUCTION:

Mulberry Avenue from Palms Drive to Houser Street has been designated for reconstruction by the City. State and Federal money will be used to pay for a portion of this project construction and the City will pay for a portion of this project. This project is in the current budget as proposed. The project design was done by Shoemaker and Holland and the final plans have been submitted to Iowa DOT for a final review. Once the plans are reviewed the consultant will need to pick up any comments and or corrections, and then resubmit to IowaDOT. Currently the project is on track to be let for construction on the May 17, 2016 letting.

BACKGROUND:

The last action taken on the project by the City was to approve and sign the City-Federal Aid Agreement. The federal funds available for this project are \$1,200,000.00. The project estimated cost is \$2.37 million. Of this total, an estimated \$350,000 is for sanitary and storm sewer improvements.

It is staff's recommendation City Council adopt the attached resolution approving the plans, specifications, form of contract, cost estimate and setting the bid opening date (handled by the IDOT) for May 17, 2016.
