Initial Meeting

I. OVERVIEW OF PARADE ROUTE

- a. Reviewed possible parade routes to be used during the construction of Mississippi Drive.
 - **Plan A** - Iowa to 3rd to Walnut to 5th (or 3rd to Mulberry to 4th just north of Courthouse).
 - **Plan B** - MHS parking lot (via Bonnie Dr) to Mulberry to Parham.
- b. Discussed other issues regarding safety. No throwing candy. Keeping people off the street with rope/construction fence.
- c. Both routes should be included with Parade Entry Forms. Routes are subject to change. 10 days' notice will be given. Will need to communicate the changes to community.

II. OVERVIEW OF FIREWORKS

- a. Discussed where the community could view the fireworks safely with Mississippi Dr being under construction during the event.
 - **Plan A** - Foot traffic will be allowed on to the Riverfront via trails and/or Iowa or Cedar entrance. At least one street entrance will remain open during construction. Mississippi Dr construction will need to be fenced off and possibly manned by volunteers to keep citizens safe.

- **Plan B** – Block off side streets Chestnut to Walnut for viewers to set up chairs.

III. OTHER DISCUSSION

- a. Soap Box Derby will go down 3rd St and back up 4th St
- b. Kids' Parade can use 3rd St
