INTRODUCTION:

At certain locations within the Mississippi Drive Corridor the contractor will need permission to get onto adjacent property owners land. There are nine (9) agreements on file signed by the property owners that need to be approved and signed by a representative of the city. A copy of the fully executed agreements will be returned to the owners.

BACKGROUND:

Examples of the need to get on adjacent owners property, is to sawcut the driveway onto a property or to sawcut an existing parking area. The amount of encroachment is minor in these instances.

The City Engineer requests the approval of these 9 Right of Entry Agreements and authorization for them to be signed by an authorized representative of the City of Muscatine.
