**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE  
IOWA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR TRAFFIC SAFETY IMPROVEMENT  
PROGRAM (TSIP) FUNDING FOR BUSINESS HIGHWAY 38/PARK AVENUE TO CONVERT  
THE 4-LANE ROAD TO 3-LANE CONFIGURATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Iowa Department of Transportation has established the TSIP and provides funding for locations where vehicular safety is a concern and documented.

**WHEREAS**, the Business Highway 38/Park Avenue corridor from Harrison Street to Highway 92 has been identified as a location where vehicular safety could be improved and funded by TSIP.

**WHEREAS**, reconfiguring the roadway to a 3-lane section will help reduce crashes and improve traffic operations.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the application with the Iowa Department of Transportation TSIP program for the Business Highway 38/Park Avenue corridor from Harrison Street to Highway 92 is hereby approved as to form and content.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and file the application on behalf of the City of Muscatine, with the Iowa Department of Transportation TSIP program for the Business Highway 38/Park Avenue corridor from Harrison Street to Highway 92.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City of Muscatine, Iowa does hereby commit to address funding for the Business Highway 38/Park Avenue corridor from Harrison Street to Highway 92 as outlined in the application at the appropriate time in the City's budgeting process.
