The Melon City Bike Club requests the closure of Weed City Park roads to vehicle traffic for the day of the bike race. Weed Park road closure would be from 6:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

As in previous years, the Melon City Bike Club members will cooperate with the Muscatine Police dept., Parks and Recreation dept. and the City Street dept. in safety measures for the Melon City Criterium.
