

TRANSIT JOINT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT
 TO IMPLEMENT A FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA)
 BUS AND BUS FACILITIES PROJECT
 [CFDA 20.526]

WHEREAS, the Iowa Department of Transportation (hereinafter called the DEPARTMENT) has, in accordance with Chapter 324A of the Code of Iowa, secured a grant under 5339 from the Federal Transit Administration on behalf of Iowa public transit systems, and

WHEREAS, the City of Muscatine (Muscatine City Transit/MuscaBus) (hereinafter called the AGENCY) has been duly designated as a public transit system by local officials, in accordance with Chapter 324A of the Code, and

WHEREAS, Grant IA-2019-007-00 (executed by FTA on 3/27/2019) includes the project detailed below, programmed for the AGENCY:


NOW, THEREFORE, THE DEPARTMENT AND THE AGENCY HAVE AGREED THAT THE AGENCY shall proceed with implementation of the above-described project, subject to all terms, conditions and obligations connected with the federal grant, and also subject to such policies, procedures and conditions as have been established by the DEPARTMENT and which are documented in Part II of this AGREEMENT (found at <https://iowadot.gov/transit/Funding-programs-and-applications/joint-participation-agreement-attachments>).

BE IT FURTHER AGREED THAT THE DEPARTMENT shall reimburse the AGENCY for eligible costs of implementing each element of said project at the participation rate(s) and subject to the funding ceiling(s) delineated above.

THIS AGREEMENT TO BE IN EFFECT from 3/27/2019, through 3/26/2021. [Any project element not obligated twelve months prior to the original expiration date of this AGREEMENT will be forfeited, unless prior written approval of other arrangement(s) is received from the DEPARTMENT.]

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

RE: Request to Accept Funding for Bus

INTRODUCTION:

The City of Muscatine Transit (MuscaBus) has received notification of availability of funding for the purchase of one, light duty transit bus. The federal funding source is Bus and Bus Facilities Project under 5339.

BACKGROUND:

This funding was acquired through the Iowa Department of Transportation, on behalf of Iowa public transit systems. Funding is at an 85% level. The City is responsible for the remaining 15% of the purchase cost. As Council may recall, the City's share of the purchase of one new bus was requested during Budget sessions.

RECOMMENDATION/RATIONALE:

It is the recommendation of the Public Works/Transit staff to accept the \$90,100.00 of federal funds offered for the purchase of one light duty, gasoline engine, transit bus. The total purchase price will not exceed \$106,000.00. The City's share will be \$15,900.00. The new bus would replace #242, a 2006, light duty, diesel bus with 270,286 miles, which has many mechanical issues and is no longer operable.


Enclosed are two originals of a partially executed FY18 BUS AND BUS FACILITIES agreement. This agreement must be signed within 60 days of the date on this letter.
