

Muscatine County Board of Supervisors
Monday, April 22, 2019

The Muscatine County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 A.M. with Holliday, Sauer, Mather, Sorensen and Saucedo present. Chairperson Mather presiding.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Saucedo, the agenda was approved as presented. Ayes: All.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Sauer, claims dated April 22, 2019 were approved in the amount of \$626,871.37. Ayes: All.

Eastern Iowa Mental Health/Disability Services Region CEO Lori Elam provided the Board with a quarterly regional update. Elam stated HF691 has passed both houses and has been sent to the Governor. Elam stated HF691 allows for a 40% fund balance carryover and gives the regions until 2023 to spend the fund balance down to the limit. Elam stated FY19 anticipated expenditures are 11.5 million dollars with 4.1 million dollars of revenue which will lower the region's fund balance to 41% at the end of FY2019, but some counties still need to lower their fund balance. Elam stated HF690 has also passed both houses and is headed to the Governor. Elam stated HF690 allows the region to manage the children's mental health system, but that there was no funding attached to the legislation.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Sauer, minutes of the April 15, 2019 regular meeting were approved as written. Ayes: All.
