D. Request to Approve the Issuance of a Purchase Order for a G.V.W. Truck Chassis for the Public Works Department

Presented for City Council's consideration is a request to approve the issuance of a purchase order in the amount of \$31,878.00, to Krieger Motor Company, for the purchase of a #14,000 G.V.W. truck chassis. This new Chassis will replace #60, a 1993 #13000 G.V.W. Ford Flat Bed Dump Truck. Three bids were

received with Krieger being the low bidder. There is \$33,000 budgeted for this purchase.

**E. Request to Approve the Issuance of a Purchase Order for Papoose Grounding Study**

This study was not budgeted but is required by Muscatine Power and Water to complete the new variable frequency drive installation. This study will be funded from the lift station operating budget and absorbed from other line items.
