INTRODUCTION: The reconstruction of Taxiway A was adopted as the first priority on the Muscatine Municipal Airport's 5-Year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) approved by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). This project is anticipated to be funded by the FAA in FY2021. Bolton & Menk has developed plans and specifications to be used in a request for bids. Prior to issuing a request for bids a public hearing must be held.

BACKGROUND: The City of Muscatine and the Airport Advisory Commission have developed a 5-Year CIP approved by FAA. The City has been notified by FAA staff that the full reconstruction of Taxiway A this fall. Ninety percent of eligible expenses are covered by the FAA grant, but prior to grant execution project design and bidding must be complete. Total estimated cost of the project is \$3,110,513, with the FAA portion being \$2,799,462. The City's portion of the project costs will be paid for with a future bond issuance.

In December Council approved Work Order 4 for the professional services contract with Bolton & Menk to complete the project design and preparation of bid documents. The plans, specifications, form of contract and estimated project costs are anticipated to be presented to City Council for approval at the April 16 meeting following the public hearing to facilitate the bid letting.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of the attached resolution setting a public hearing to consider the plans, specifications, and form of contract for the reconstruction of Taxiway A at the Muscatine Municipal Airport for April 16 at 7:00 p.m.
