Purchase of (3) three Chevy Pursuit Rated 4WD Patrol Tahoe's

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purchase of these Chevy Tahoe's will replace three current Tahoe's in our current fleet. The Police Department will filter these older Tahoe's to replace even older squads within the department that need replacement, such as the GTSB (Governors Traffic Safety Bureau), K-9 or SRO (School Resource Officer) vehicles.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends city council approve the (3) three Chevy Tahoe's

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Police Department requested five (5) Chevy Tahoe's during this year budget session. City council asked that we purchase three (3). We can then look at budgeting two (2) Chevy Tahoe's in FY 21/22. It was determined that we could then reevaluate it in a couple of years to see what the maintenance impact was. We had been on every other year purchase of five (5) Patrol vehicles.

CITY FINANCIAL IMPACT

The Police Department has \$147,000 budgeted for three (3) Tahoe's. This total amount includes the tear out and install costs of the new Tahoe's. There were only two (2) bids received for the Tahoe's.

Kriegers \$41,456 per Tahoe

Karl Chevrolet (Ankeny) \$37,311 per Tahoe

The Police Department requests city council to approve a Purchase Order in the amount of \$111,933 to Karl Chevrolet for the purchase of three (3) Chevy Pursuit Rated 4WD Patrol Tahoe's.
