EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Staff requests the approval of a purchase order in the amount of \$81,095.00 to ILoca Services Inc. of Davenport Iowa for a 2021 aluminum transfer trailer.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Council approve the issuance of a purchase order in the amount of \$81,095.00 to ILoca Services Inc. This is for the purchase of a 2021 45ft Mac aluminum transfer trailer.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The City of Muscatine owns four transfer trailers that are used to haul waste collected at the Transfer Station to the Muscatine County Sanitary Landfill. The request for bids to purchase a new trailer was advertised and one bid was received and opened on July 8th at City Hall. The new trailer purchased will replace a 2001 CTS transfer trailer that is well beyond its ten year life expectancy. In FY 2020 a similar Mac trailer was purchased and staff are pleased with its performance and durability.

CITY FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is \$78,000.00 budgeted in the Transfer Station capital budget. The remaining \$3,095.00 will be covered by the sale of the old equipment at auction later this year and/or the Transfer Station operating budget.
