RE: Street Striping Bids

INTRODUCTION:

Annually the City of Muscatine receives bids for street striping.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Muscatine, like all other public entities, is required to use a water based paint due to the concerns traditional oil based paint presented. This rule has been in place for the past several years. The downside to the water vs. oil base is the poor longevity of water based paints. It quickly wears away leaving a faint street striping paint product after several months.

RECOMMENDATION/RATIONALE:

The City received bids on April 18, 2013 for the street striping service. Two bids were received:

Peterson Parking Lot Striping --- \$45,419.28
Weikert Contracting --- \$43,491.72

The Roadway Maintenance Operation has \$50,000 budgeted for this service. It is our recommendation to issue a Purchase Order to Weikert Contracting for \$43,491.72.
