

AIRPORT ADVISORY COMMISSION MINUTES
MONDAY – JUNE 24, 2013
AIRPORT TERMINAL BUILDING

The Muscatine Airport Advisory Commission meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Commission Vice-Chairperson Bill Leddy. Commissioners present were Bill Leddy, Jerald Cale, and Stacy Lewis. Commissioners Jerry Page and Scott Natvig were excused. Also present was Steven Boka, Director of Community Development, and Carver Aero employees Janet Lewis and Mike Woerly.

The Minutes of the April 22, 2013 meeting were approved on a motion by Commissioner Lewis and seconded by Commissioner Cale. All present voted aye.

Boka then provided a brief update on current projects. Commissioners discussed the status of the Obstruction Removal Project and the anticipated schedule for the new AWOS.

Boka provided the Commission with an update on the recent runway blow-up. The repairs will be made by Muscatine Bridge and will be paid by the state (70%) and the city (30%). Work is scheduled to begin as soon as weather permits.

Boka reviewed the status of the 2014 recommended state aviation funding awards for the state of Iowa and noted that the Muscatine Airport is scheduled to receive \$49,189 in state funding toward the security gate and camera installation. The city is also scheduled to receive \$143,200 toward the T-hangar and apron drainage project. The local share for these two projects is \$8,681 and \$25,270 respectively.

The Commissioners discussed the need for additional hangar space and how the construction might be funded. Boka explained that the city needs to complete the zoning ordinance update and the Airport Layout Plan (ALP) before the state and FAA will consider any request to fund vertical infrastructure.

reported that he and Commissioner Page attended the recent State Aviation Conference in April and both were able to meet with federal and state aviation officials regarding a number of airport related projects.
