INTRODUCTION:

The Iowa Department of Transportation opened bids for the Colorado Street Reconstruction Project on September 17, 2013.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Muscatine has been planning the reconstruction of Colorado Street for the past several years. The plan for Colorado is to make it a "Complete Street" roadway accommodating all forms of traffic – pedestrian, public transit, cycling and vehicular. Sidewalks are a major improvement to this reconstruction plan.

RECOMMENDATION/RATIONALE:

The low bid was submitted by Heuer Construction at \$2,849,949.71, and City Council awarded the contract for this project to them at its October 3, 2013 meeting. Staff is recommending that City Council approve the contract and bond.
