SUBJECT:

In-Depth Discussion / Resolution Establishing Various New Fees

INTRODUCTION:

In accordance with the direction of city staff and council the Muscatine Fire Department surveyed other Iowa Fire Departments to review and research various fees for service and associated permits related to fire department operations.

BACKGROUND:

The Muscatine City Code provides for a variety of charges (fees) for services. City staff and City Council regularly reviews these charges as part of the annual budget preparation and approval process. The Muscatine Fire Department surveyed other Iowa Fire Departments and compiled a list of comparable fees. After reviewing and analyzing the fees the Fire Department created a draft resolution establishing fees related to fire department inspections, re-inspections, and various fire department permit and processing fees for the City of Muscatine. The projected revenues for implementing the new fees are \$ 21, 160. It should be noted that the majority of these fees are directly related to the cost of providing a particular service.

RECOMMENDATION/RATIONALE:

No action is needed as of today, but the purpose of the in-depth presentation is to cover the proposed fee schedule and we will come back to council on March 17th recommending that council approve the new resolution establishing fees related to fire department inspection, reinspection, and various fire department permits and processing fees for the City of Muscatine.

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FEES RELATED TO FIRE DEPARTMENT INSPECTION, RE-INSPECTION, AND VARIOUS FIRE DEPARMTENT PERMIT AND PROCESSING FEES FOR THE CITY OF MUSCATINE.

- WHEREAS, the City Code for the City of Muscatine, Iowa, provides for a variety of City Services, reviews and inspections; and
- WHEREAS, the City Code allows for the City Council to establish fees associated with these various activities by resolution; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Muscatine, Iowa, has reviewed these fees and supports an increase;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF MUSCATINE, that pursuant to the provisions of the City Code, the following fees are established:

Initial Inspection \$ 75.00 hr (includes inspection and admin time)

1st Re-Inspection No Charge (performed 30 days after initial)

2nd or more re-inspections \$ 75.00 hr
