Parade: KWPC and Local Access Channel for video and voice during the parade.

At the Symphony concert there will be programming that is not determined at this time the MSO would need to supply.

9. List mechanical or electronic equipment to be used:

The connection to the local access channel at Musser Public Library and the riverfront speaker system.

There will be approximately 80-100 entries in the parade with various vehicles including bicycles, cars, fire and police, pickups with and without trailers, golf carts, ATVs, utility vehicles, farm tractors, MPW vehicles, and semi tractors with and without trailers.

Typically we have had dogs, and other small domestic animals along with horses with or without carriages.

12. A description of any sound amplification to be used:

The entries may have small sound equipment for their purposes... usually something like a boom box.

13. Proposed monitoring of the group and/or activity including the number of people who will direct traffic, set up, clean up and maintain order, if necessary:

We provide block captains that assist with the line up and help to maintain order during the parade~ 12 people. In the past we have sometimes assisted with traffic control at the intersections of 5th and Iowa during the parade lineup. It works best for traffic control to have Iowa one way from Fulliam to 4th with the flow toward the river while the parade is lining up

14. All plans for the provision of security:

GMCCI requires a control access point on the fireworks site. We have a master shooter that is responsible for the pyrotechnic crew and Rock Island County Sheriff's depart has deputy assigned to the shoot site. We use the DNR and Muscatine Search and Rescue to maintain controlled access on the Mississippi.

GMCCI does allow vendors to sell food items, if they have a permit from the City. Other vendors may sell glow jewelery, trinkets, and provide entertainment like inflatables, if they have paid vendor fees which are used for the 4th of July expenses.


