Re: Renovate Municipal Hangar and T-Hangar Roofs - Muscatine Municipal Airport

INTRODUCTION: In August of 2010, The City of Muscatine was awarded funding by the IDOT Division of Aviation for the renovation of the Municipal Hangar and T-Hangar Roofs at the Municipal Airport. These funds were awarded through the State Division of Aviation 2011 Airport Development Program.

BACKGROUND: The City annually submits an application to our state and federal partners for projects at the Muscatine Airport that are identified on the 5-year Capital Improvement Program. The most recent state awarded project was the Hangar Access Road that is essentially complete and will provide road access for future hangar development, as well as serve the area intended for the construction of a new joint Army Reserve/ National Guard Armory facility located in the southeast corner of the airport property. This project will permit the city to renovate the municipal hangar and make repairs to some of the T-Hangar roofs. Total funds awarded for the project include \$49,300.00 in state funding and a local match of \$8,700.00.

RECOMMENDATION/RATIONALE: It is recommended that City Council approve the attached resolution setting a date for a public hearing on the Plans, Specifications, Form of Contract, Engineers Estimate and establishing a bid opening date for the project identified as "Renovate Municipal Hangar and T-Hangar Roofs" at the Muscatine Municipal Airport.
