Emerson Taylor, Youth Services Supervisor, is opening the doors to the greater community by incorporating local businesses and organizations like Good Karma Jewelry and Bread Studio, **Black Pearl Café**, and **West Hill Cakery** as presenters in the summer reading program. Musser Library is also partnering with Muscatine County Conservation, Iowa DNR, Iowa State Extension, and the 4-H programs of Muscatine.

"Every child is as unique as their interests, and the library is the place for them to begin their adventure," Taylor said. "This summer, Musser has formed community partnerships to highlight events that our community has to offer its youth while fostering a love of reading and learning."

This summer will also include weekly programs including Adventure Story Hike with Mr. Taylor, City Department Storytime, Infant-Toddler Swim Storytime at the Aquatic Center, and Tween Scene Craft Drop-in alongside beloved Library programs like O Baby Lapsit and Preschool Storytime.

Young Summer Readers will have the opportunity to take part in the Musser Summer Activities Challenge by attending community events to earn badges. These can include participating in a Muscatine Conservation camp (Outdoor Adventure Badge), attending a Muscatine Art Center program (Love Your Adventure Badge), checking out a "how to" book from the library (Your Learning Adventure Badge), and attending the 4th of July parade (Adventure in Your Community Badge).

The final badge is the 100 Hours Outside Parks and Rec Badge that encourages children to play outside this summer.
