Explanation of significant increases in the budget:

Liability, Property & Self Insurance - to fund increased costs of property and liability insurance. Employee benefits - to fund increased costs for FICA, IPERS, and employee insurance costs. Emergency Levy - to continue current service levels to residents. Transit - to re-institute this levy that was not needed during the COVID-19 pandemic due to increased grant funding. To fund inflationary cost increases of providing the same level of services to our residents.
